2009 Laguna Niguel Christmas Parade Information

Dear ANHS Music Parents and Students,

Our ANHS Band and Color Guard will be once again performing in the Laguna Niguel Christmas Parade on Saturday, December 12. This is a community event that our band will be representing our school, along with being televised.

Please read the information below in regards to specific details about this parade:

- Students need to pick their instrument and uniform (no shako) on Friday after school and bring everything home. Uniforms need to be washed over the weekend (See washing instructions below) and returned with their instruments on Monday, December 14.
- All Band Students need to wear a “RED” Santa Hat for our parade.
 - Can be purchased at Target or other store.
- Report Time for the parade is 10:15 am
- Students need to be dropped off at the corner of Moulton Parkway and Crown Valley Parkway. You will see drop off signs at the specific corner.
- If the parade is on-time, we should step off by should be between 11:30 am to 12 noon.
- The parade will end just prior to the Crown Valley Community Park on Crown Valley Parkway, just before Niguel Road.
 - This is your pickup point for your son or daughter
- If students are driving themselves, they will have to park their car in the Crown Valley Community Park parking lot and then walk to the set-up area at the corner of Crown Valley and Moulton Parkway.

ATTENTION ALL STUDENTS: Remember to return uniform to school on Monday, December 14. You will receive an “F” grade for the parade performance if your uniform is NOT returned on the above date.

All students are asked to wash their band uniforms after the parade. Please follow the directions below on washing your uniform---see page #2

UNIFORM WASHING INSTRUCTIONS –

- . Remove the sequined sash – do not wash or dry PLEASE
- . Zip up the jacket and bib overall zippers
- . Wash both together (alone please) in cold water, gentle cycle with mild detergent
- . Dry in warm (permanent press) cycle
- . You can tell if the uniform is completely dry by checking the shoulders
- . Hang them up right out of the dryer
- . Snap back on the sash
- . Please do not iron the uniforms
- . If any hems are coming out and you are able to fix them....thank you! Please do that before you launder the item

We really appreciate your help getting the uniforms put away nice and clean until next BAND SEASON!!!!
