### Grading:

#### **Concert Performance Assessment - 40%**

Students are expected to participate and be on time to all performances. Students who are not in full uniform or late to a performance will not receive full credit for the performance. Unexcused absences from a performance will result in a lowered grade. An alternate assignment may be assigned for an excused performance to earn credit for a missed performance at the discretion of the director.

#### **Individual Performance Assessment - 40%**

Starting in semester two all testing for this section will be done on smart music. By now you have had a full semester to get acquainted with the program. Each week you will be assigned a new unit on a key signature or music we are working on in class.

#### **Each key signature unit will be worth 50 points.**

Scale of assigned key	15 points
Mini scales	5 points
Scale pattern 1	5 points
Scale pattern 2	5 points
Chord Study 1	5 points
Chord Study 2	15 points

Students will receive 25 extra credit points for each honor band that you audition & participate in

#### **Class Performance Assessment/Citizenship - 20%**

Each week you will earn 5 points towards your classroom performance assessment. Students who forget their instrument, supplies, music, etc. will not earn credit for that day. Any absence or two unexcused tardies will count towards a lost of credit for that week. Mondays will be worth one point and Wednesday/Fridays will be worth 2 points. Helping at fundraisers or if you are asked to do something that will help benefit the program will also count under this section.
