

Committees/Areas of volunteer need

Uniforms

Volunteers in this area assist in measuring students for uniforms, handing out uniforms, assisting with t-shirts/jackets, handing out and collecting plumes at performances, and solving minor uniform 'crisis' at performances (lost gloves, etc.). You do not need to know how to sew to assist with uniforms, but if you know how to sew, please sign up to help with uniforms and indicate that you can sew on the other side! Alterations to colorguard uniforms, flags, etc. are also needed as well.

Logistics/Support

Logistics is a broad term that covers many volunteer needs. We load 2 trucks full of band/percussion instruments, props, and tailgate supplies. We need assistance in loading and driving the trucks, as well as driving the percussion equipment to the field at competitions. Also, this is the area that organizes chaperone support, bus riders, handing out water at competitions, assisting in the stands at football games, etc. The logistic team also helps to build props, and provide maintenance to band and colorguard needs. This area has been split up on the volunteer interest sheet to better reflect your specific area of interest

Tailgate(Student Meals)

We feed students at every competition. We also use our tailgate for many fundraisers throughout the year, including our spring colorguard and drumline competitions that we host at Aliso Niguel. Volunteer support in this area may include shopping for food, cooking food, collecting money at the tailgate, etc.

Fundraising

Assistance in fundraising can consist of organizing a fundraiser, collecting and organizing products and/or money for fundraisers, advertising, and general support for our various fundraisers. If you have experience in fundraising/soliciting donations from corporations/grant writing with other groups (little league, soccer, girl scouts, etc.), your assistance would help in this area.

Chaperones

This team is in charge of helping Mr. Otani with checking the kids on and off of the busses. The chaperone team would ride on the bus to and from the competition. Their team would also follow the group through warm up and on the field and provide assistance as needed.

Travel
